Could China's solar panels help meet Africa's energy needs?

From Algeria on the Mediterranean coast to landlocked Zambia in the south, countries across Africa have been importing significantly more solar panels from China this year than in the past, which analysts say could be the start of a massive effort to help meet the continent's power demands with renewable energy instead of fossil fuels.

Which country imports the most solar panels in Africa?

Historically, South Africa dominated solar imports in Africa, at one point accounting for roughly half of all panels shipped to the continent. The latest data show its share has slipped below a third as demand surged elsewhere.

How many solar panels did Africa Import in May 2025?

In May 2025, African countries imported a combined 1.57 Gigawatts of solar panels from China, an all time high. (Think of it as adding three-fourths of the capacity of the Hoover Dam in one month.)

Where are solar panels coming from in Africa?

In North Africa, countries like Algeria and Egypt are building massive utility-scale solar power plants that require large numbers of panels. But in Sub-Saharan Africa, the panels are being imported by more rural communities in places that traditionally haven't been connected to the grid at all.

South Africa remained the biggest solar importer in Africa with 3.8 GW of solar panels from China, with Nigeria second (1.7 GW) and Algeria rising to third (1.2 GW).

A report shows that Africa has emerged as the world's fastest-growing solar market even as global growth slowed last year, driven by a 60% surge in imports of solar panels from China.

In 2024, China produced 80% of the world's solar panels and remains by far the largest exporter. Africa's dependence on imports is heavy because local manufacturing capacity is still minimal.
