

# Find my android

How do I Find my Lost Android phone?

Sign in to your primary Google account. Click the lost phone in the upper-left corner. A Google Map appears, showing where your Android smartphone is located. If it's turned off, you'll see your phone's location from when it was last on the network. Click Play sound to ring the phone for five minutes, even if it's on silent/vibrate.

How does find my device work?

The Find My Device service will pinpoint your phone's exact location on the map and provide details about network connectivity and battery life. If Find My Device can't locate your smartphone, the Android device is either closed or not connected to the internet. Now that you can see where your lost Android device is, let's go over...

How do I Find my Android device?

On it, tap Devices at the bottom (highlighted 1 in the screenshot), make sure My devices is selected (2), and choose the Android device you want to locate (3). Note that if you have many devices, they might not all be visible by default.
