How many US military bases are there in Western Asia?

As of June 2025, approximately 40,000 American troops are stationed in Western Asia, primarily on naval ships, with the remainder distributed across 19 military bases. Key locations include Bahrain, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Kuwait, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Syria, and the United Arab Emirates, with eight permanent bases among them.

What is a US military base in West Asia?

About US military bases in West Asia: Significance: Controls US naval operations in the Gulf, Red Sea, Arabian Sea, and Indian Ocean. Base: Al Udeid Air Base. Significance: Forward HQ of US Central Command; houses ~10,000 troops; critical for operations from Egypt to Kazakhstan. Significance: Supports troop deployments into Iraq and Syria.

Where is the US military located in Western Asia?

The U.S.'s military footprint in Western Asia dates back to July 1958, when the first base was established amidst the Lebanon crisis. A prime example of this presence is the Al Udeid military base, located just outside Doha, Qatar, spanning 24 hectares and serving as the headquarters for U.S. Central Command.

How many US military bases are there?

The billions of dollars are spent on producing war materiel, investing in military research and technology, and maintaining its military presence outside American soil. Currently, the US military is present in more than 80 countries with 750 bases across the globe in the guise of global peace-keeping and security (Vine, 2021).
