How much does electricity cost in Portugal?

With that said, the average household electricity price in Portugal runs around EUR0.24-EUR0.26 per kWh (all taxes included), with summer rates nearer the lower end and winter peaks pushing toward the higher figure. Before taxes and levies, you're typically paying about EUR0.17-EUR0.18 per kWh.
