

In this section, we address a frequently posed inquiry regarding the provision of electric power to external devices, including sheds, lighting fixtures, and beyond.

All electrical installations in the UK must comply with the requirements in BS 7671, which is designed for use by electrical systems designers, manufacturers, contractors, engineers, inspectors, and regulators.

The new ecodesign requirements for external power supplies have applied since 1 April 2020, during the transition period, and therefore apply directly in the UK.
