Will the Vatican replace its car fleet with electric vehicles?

ROME (AP) -- The Vatican signed an agreement Wednesday with German carmaker Volkswagen AG to gradually replace its auto fleet with electric vehicles as part of the Vatican's efforts to reduce its carbon emissions. The announcement did not give any details on the value of the deal or set a timetable for completing the switch to electric vehicles.

Does the Vatican have a partnership with Volkswagen?

Volkswagen's Italia group didn't immediately reply to an email seeking details about the partnership. The Vatican has signed an agreement with Volkswagen to gradually replace its auto fleet with electric vehicles.

What does the Vatican's 'ecological conversion 2030' deal mean?

The announcement did not give any details on the value of the deal or set a timetable for completing the switch to electric vehicles. The partnership falls under the Vatican's "Ecological Conversion 2030" plan, which aims to pursue sustainable, carbon-neutral projects and technologies in the 44-hectare (109-acre) city state in the center of Rome.

How will New York replace its fleet with electric vehicles?

The administration said it intends to gradually replace its fleet with electric vehicles by 2030, will increase the number of charging stations throughout the territory and ensure the city state's energy needs are provided exclusively by renewable sources.

The Vatican City State intends "to make its car fleet carbon neutral by 2030" by replacing all its vehicles with electric ones, it announced in a press release on November 15, 2023. To this ...
